CURRENT RESEARCH:

My plans for the years ahead are to study the restructuring of the Israeli financial system. Until the mid-1980s, the Israeli financial system, like that of other developmental states, such as France and South Korea, was a state-led structure, and the commercial banks served as the state's arm for the mobilization and allocation of capital. The Israeli financial system, similar to that of France, shifted to a hybrid system with both a bank- and market-based structure. Currently, I am conducting research on the construction of the non-bank credit market, with special focus on the case of the formation of the corporate bond market. This research will draw on insights from the literature in economic sociology, comparative political economy and institutional change. I plan to write a book on the restructuring of the Israeli financial system from a comparative perspective.
